MEDICAL SERVICES include pregnancy testing, ultrasounds, options coaching, and medical referrals in each of our centers. In 2024, over 72% of clients with a positive pregnancy test chose life. Out of the total pregnancy tests, 175 clients were initially considering abortion, and 115 ultimately chose life.

⁶⁶ A visit to the ER is always surrounded by fear and uncertainty. What's causing the pain? Tests and scans, poking and prodding and a thousand guestions. That was the setting that Haleigh found herself in when she found out she was pregnant. Only sixteen years old and afraid and in the ER - with her parents - she learned the truth. Amidst the shock and disbelief, one profound message sounded through the stories shared by both her and her parents: Deep concern for each other. While Haleigh wrestled with shock and disbelief at the news she was deeply concerned: How did her parents feel? How hard is this impacting them? Her father shared his deepest concern: How did Haileigh feel? How was this impacting her? The deep empathy each shared for the other exhibited the very bond within that family. Haileigh commented on the great impact Positive Options had throughout that season. They brought nothing but encouragement and help through the Positive Options education program and personal care from an advocate. It is our honor to be a source of support and hope to young mothers and fathers as they navigate the new waters of pregnancy and parenthood. Together we are shining the light, bringing the Gospel and loving people - to life!

Topics include: Pregnancy and Birth, Parenting, Coparenting, Life Skills, Fatherhood, Bible studies and so much more!

66 Erin and Ryan were excited but unprepared for the challenges of parenthood. When they learned they were expecting their first child, Sarah, they felt lost and unsure where to turn. But Erin's search for support led them to Positive Options, where they found the guidance and hope they needed.

The classes they took didn't just teach practical parenting skills—they brought peace and strengthened their bond. Instead of arguing over little things, they grew as partners, facing challenges together.

One day at Walmart, Erin overheard a young woman in the restroom, just learning she was pregnant. Remembering her own journey, she approached with warmth and used the points she earned through Positive Options to help with diapers and baby essentials.

As Erin handed over the items, she saw the same uncertainty she once felt—and the same spark of hope. In that moment, she realized Positive Options hadn't just shaped her family—it had empowered her to help others, too.

Since 2016, Positive Options has served the local Church with training and equipping for life discipleship, known as Community Life. In 2024, the Community Life team launched under a new name: The Joshua Center for Cultural Discipleship. The **JOSHUA CENTER** exists to mobilize the body of Christ to embody the Gospel as we build a culture of abundant life for families in West Michigan.

Pastor Mark, a leader in a broader church partnership, has long championed life-affirming ministry and collaboration. His perspective shifted when he realized how many in the church face abortion decisions.

"The thought that young people under my care might not come to me for help with an unexpected pregnancy decision broke my heart. Something is missing in the church's pro-life message, and God had to change my heart to correct that."

Through Positive Options' Joshua Center initiative and other partnerships, Mark equips his team and the wider church for life discipleship, ensuring the church is a safe, informed first place for pregnancy decisions.

"People don't just need to hear abortion is a bad choice; they need to know their church is here to help and how. Prayer is a must, but there are practical steps we can take."

ABORTION AFTERCARE program offers compassionate support and practical help for individuals and families navigating the complex emotions and decisions surrounding pregnancy loss. We provide a safe, confidential, and nonjudgmental space for healing. We offer one-on-one mentoring sessions, educational resources, and a wide range of support groups and workshops.

When Emma was 18, she had a feeling she might be pregnant. Nervous and alone, she took a pregnancy test in the store bathroom. When it turned positive, a wave of uncertainty washed over her. She went with her boyfriend's sister to a clinic, and on the way, they passed a group of women who spoke to her with kindness. Emma's heart tugged as she listened, but the pressure to keep moving forward felt strong. Inside the clinic, she felt conflicted but pushed through, trying to numb herself from the emotions that filled her. Years later, Emma found herself in a similar situation. This time, she was working as a nanny, and when she shared her feelings with her employer, the woman simply said, "Let's take a test together." When it confirmed Emma's pregnancy, she felt a sense of peace.

For the first time, she felt truly supported and knew she would choose life. Today, Emma is a proud single mom to her five-year-old daughter, Nevaya. Every time she looks at Nevaya, Emma is reminded of her journey to healing and the grace that carried her through. Places like Positive Options were there for her when she needed them most, showing her that she was never truly alone.





ABORTION

Positive Options provides pregnancy confirmation and pregnancy options counsel to men and women considering a pregnancy decision.

WE DO NOT perform or refer for abortions, facilitate adoptions, or provide full prenatal care.

WE DO provide early pregnancy services, referrals to adoption agencies, parenting support programs, and abortion aftercare.

Positive Options is here as the first step in any pregnancy journey. Our professionally trained staff is ready to provide compassionate, knowledgeable care that supports our clients as they process their options and make an informed decision.

We believe that, for abortion to be a choice, other choices need to feel possible. We help our clients identify factors and barriers influencing their pregnancy decision and empower them with support and solutions, so that abortion feels like one choice, and not their only choice.

BIRTH CONTROL

WE DO NOT provide emergency or regular contraceptives.

In local schools and in our centers, Positive Options encourages abstinence, in alignment with both our statement of faith and with public health recommendations for sexual risk avoidance (SRA).^[1] We recommend our married clients speak with their healthcare provider and pastoral leader about family planning options.

more than half of abortions are now performed through the abortion pill instead of a surgical procedure. The abortion pill is a two-step regimen that includes the drugs mifepristone and misoprostol. In 2021, the FDA approved the prescription of the abortion pill via telehealth. However, until recently, mifepristone could only be prescribed by certain doctors, clinics, and mail-order pharmacies. That changed in 2023, when the FDA loosened

restrictions, allowing essentially any pharmacy to dispense the medication. ^[3] This change, coupled with telehealth services and new mail-order options, dramatically expands abortion availability.

The FDA has approved the abortion pill regimen through 10 weeks of pregnancy; [4] however, many providers are prescribing through 13 weeks. [5] At any stage of pregnancy, the abortion pill carries a medical risk. This risk is increased with each week of pregnancy, or when women do not have an in-person consult and ultrasound prior to taking the medications. [6]

ABORTION PILL REVERSAL is an option for women who experience regret after taking the first step of mifepristone, but before taking the second step of misoprostol. At Positive Options, we are committed to serving women who are considering, or have already had, an abortion. For both safety and certainty, it is important to have an ultrasound prior to making an abortion decision. We always recommend women first see us for an appointment, and not to take the abortion pill via an online provider.

MYTH

Positive Options doesn't care about helping families once their children are born.

FACT

Positive Options is committed to providing ongoing support to help build healthy, happy families and breaking cycles of poverty, dysfunction, and abuse. This includes parenting classes, mentoring and discipleship, material services, and referrals to other resources. In 2024 we distributed 518 cans of formula and over 44,000 diapers for free to help needs in our local communities.

MYTH

Positive Options only helps women who decide to continue their pregnancy.

FACT

Positive Options is here to serve and support men and women no matter what they decide for their pregnancy. While we hope for a life-affirming outcome, we care deeply for those wounded by an abortion decision, and provide abortion aftercare to men and women who desire healing from a past abortion.



MYTH

Positive Options client services have a hidden cost.

FACT

All of Positive Options services - in our centers, area schools, and local churches - are at no cost to our clients. We never bill insurance or charge for an appointment. When uninsured, we help our clients to obtain medical coverage for the rest of their prenatal care. We do not receive any government assistance. All of our services and programs are funded by the generous support of our community.





MYTH

Positive Options is only for women.



FACT

At Positive Options, we are passionate about empowering men to lead, support, and protect their families. We encourage fathers to come to every appointment, and have an incredible team of male coaches who are eager to meet with our fatherhood clients. We believe that men have an important voice and vital part to play in building healthy families.

MYTH

Positive Options is only for women experiencing an unplanned pregnancy.

FACT

Many of our clients already plan to continue their pregnancy, but come to us as a first-step in their pregnancy journey. They may be a first-time parent with lots of questions, new to the area, or have some resource needs. We help our clients to confirm their pregnancy, get started with prenatal care, connect with other area resources, and prepare for parenthood.

MYTH

Positive Options is judgmental and manipulates women to continue their pregnancy.



FACT

At Positive Options, one of our core values is to respect choice. Sometimes people wonder, "What does that mean? Aren't you pro-life?" We are, and we hope to give each of our clients the best opportunity to make a life-affirming choice. However, when abortion is chosen, we are committed to extending the forgiveness, hope, and healing that is available in Jesus. Clients reported a positive experience, with 99% saying they would recommend us to a friend.
