MEDICAL SERVICES include pregnancy testing, ultrasounds, limited prenatal consultation, and medical referrals in each of our centers.

In 2023, over 78% of clients with a positive pregnancy test chose life; Over 92* of the 165 clients of those considering abortion chose to carry. *Number varies as not all clients report back to Positive Options

At 19, Olivia's life took an unexpected turn during a routine visit to urgent care. The nurse's unexpected words, "You're pregnant," left her disoriented, overwhelmed by concerns about her disrupted plans, her friends' judgments, and how her church would react. Sharing the news with her parents, she braced for difficulty but found their overwhelming love and support, reinforcing her faith. Even the church elders responded with compassion.

A life-changing moment came during her first ultrasound at Positive Options, where Olivia was awestruck by the image of her baby. Mary Beth and the entire team warmly embraced her, making her feel at home. As a young mother, she discovered inner strength and a deep love for her baby, Asher, juggling motherhood and pursuing her dreams. In this unexpected journey, Olivia found hope, resilience, and the power of love, strengthening her faith in her community and herself. 99





PROJECT BESTLIFE (PBL) is our proactive youth education program. We educate upper elementary and middle school students on the changes that come with puberty, and equip students with needed knowledge and skills to implement informed decisions about their relational and sexual health in order to help them live their best lives. This year has been an exciting year of growth. We revised our HEALTHY MIND, HEALTHY BODY, HEALTHY ME fourth and fifth grade curricula. For the first time, we've made PBL curricula available for licensing by outside organizations. In addition, PBL added three more schools to our schedule and one more educator to better serve the growing number of schools and students we serve. God has immensely blessed this program.

counseling but instead told, "We can take care of your problem." She felt that there was no other option so she had an abortion. Fast forward to today, Mara, now married with a child, found herself haunted by shame, leading to a painful divorce. In her sorrow, she encountered Jesus, who called her to "come home" to God. Opening her Bible and returning to church, her love for Christ grew, and God healed her heart. Restored and given a new chapter, Mara met Mark, and their marriage thrives on God's grace. For over six years, they've shared their story of redemption in their church community. Mara takes the message everywhere: **God is able to save and heal to the uttermost, even into the darkest, crushed corners of our soul. (Heb 7:25)**

When clients participate in our educational classes, they earn points to spend in our Baby Boutique providing them with much needed **MATERIAL RESOURCES**. Our clients not only get good information equipping them to be the best parents they can be, but they also earn much needed items for their children. Because of generous donors, our "stores" are well-stocked with clothing, blankets, diapers, toys and so much more!

When Yesenia became pregnant with her first child at 16, she turned to Positive Options for guidance and support. Living at home with her mother, she had to tell her about the pregnancy. Feeling the weight of fear and uncertainty heavily on her, she revealed the news of her pregnancy. Thankfully, her mother navigated the storm of emotions well and remained a source of comfort

and help. Instead of judgment, Seneida, Yesenia's mother, offered unwavering support and reminded her that she was not alone. Yesenia returned to Positive Options for her second pregnancy and took classes to learn about pregnancy and parenting. After the birth of her youngest son, Yesenia noticed her older son stepping up to provide a caring male role-model for his little brother. Yesenia reflected on her journey. "With the support of Positive Options and my mother, I became a better parent." She remains grateful for her mother's love and assistance throughout this challenging but transformative experience. **9**







WHAT DOES POSITIVE OPTIONS NOT DO?

ABORTION

Positive Options provides pregnancy confirmation and pregnancy options counsel to men and women considering a pregnancy decision. We **DO NOT** perform or refer for abortions, facilitate adoptions, or provide full prenatal care. We **DO** provide early pregnancy services, referrals to adoption agencies, parenting support programs, and abortion aftercare.

Positive Options is here as the first step in any pregnancy journey. Our professionally trained staff is ready to provide compassionate, knowledgeable care that supports our clients as they process their options and make an informed decision.

We believe that, for abortion to be a choice, other choices need to feel possible. We help our clients identify factors and barriers influencing their pregnancy decision and empower them with support and solutions, so that abortion feels like one choice, and not their only choice.

BIRTH CONTROL

Positive Options **DOES NOT** provide emergency or regular contraceptives. In local schools and in our centers, Positive Options encourages abstinence, in alignment with both our statement of faith and with public health recommendations for sexual risk avoidance (SRA).¹ We recommend our married clients speak with their healthcare provider and pastoral leader about family planning options.

Following the overturn of Roe v. Wade in June of 2022 and the subsequent passage of Proposal 3 in November, a pressing question has emerged: **"WHAT NOW?"** For decades, under Roe, abortion was legal in Michigan' until viability, typically around 24 weeks gestation. However, the 2022 Proposal 3 amended the Michigan constitution, enshrining abortion as a protected right. Presently, abortion remains legal in Michigan until 'viability,' defined as the stage of pregnancy when a fetus has developed enough to survive outside the uterus with medical assistance, as outlined in the 'Reproductive Health Act' (RHA). While this potentially allows for late-term abortions, it's important to note that abortion providers in Michigan are currently adhering to the same guidelines as before the overturn of Roe v. Wade.²

Positive Options is committed to providing ongoing support to help build healthy, happy families and breaking cycles of poverty, dysfunction, and abuse. This includes parenting classes, mentoring and discipleship, material services, and referrals to other resources. In 2023 we distributed over 400 cans of formula and over 4200 diapers for free to help needs in our local communities

Positive Options only helps women who decide to continue their pregnancy.

> Positive Options is here to serve and support men and women no matter what they decide for their pregnancy. While we hope for a life-affirming outcome, we care deeply for those wounded by an abortion decision, and provide abortion aftercare to men and women who desire healing from a past abortion.

Positive Options is only for women.

At Positive Options, we are passionate about empowering men to lead, support, and protect their families. We encourage fathers to come to every appointment, and have an incredible team of male coaches who are eager to meet with our fatherhood clients. We believe that men have an important voice and vital part to play in building healthy families.

VS. FACTS

Positive Options is only for women experiencing an unplanned pregnancy.

> Many of our clients already plan to continue their pregnancy, but come to us as a first-step in their pregnancy journey. They may be a first-time parent with lots of questions, new to the area, or have some resource needs. We help our clients to confirm their pregnancy, get started with prenatal care, connect with other area resources, and prepare for parenthood.



Positive Options client services have a hidden cost.

All of Positive Options services - in our centers, area schools, and local churches - are at no cost to our clients. We never bill insurance or charge for an appointment. When uninsured, we help our clients to obtain medical coverage for the rest of their prenatal care. We do not receive any government assistance. All of our services and programs are funded by the generous support of our community.

Positive Options is judgmental and manipulates women to continue their pregnancy.

> At Positive Options, one of our core values is to respect choice. Sometimes people wonder, "What does that mean? Aren't you pro-life?" We are, and we hope to give each of our clients the best opportunity to make a life-affirming choice. However, when abortion is chosen, we are committed to extending the forgiveness, hope, and healing that is available in Jesus. 99% of our clients surveyed reported a positive experience and said they would recommend us to a friend.

AT-HOME ABORTIONS

More than half of abortions are now performed through the abortion pill instead of a surgical procedure.¹ The abortion pill is a two-step regimen that includes the drugs mifepristone and misoprostol. In 2021, the FDA approved the prescription of the abortion pill via telehealth.² However, until recently, mifepristone could only be prescribed by certain doctors, clinics, and mail-order pharmacies. That changed in 2023, when the FDA



loosened restrictions, allowing essentially any pharmacy to dispense the medication.³ This change, coupled with telehealth services and new mail-order options, dramatically expands abortion availability.

The FDA has approved the abortion pill regimen through 10 weeks of pregnancy;⁴ however, many providers are prescribing through 13 weeks.⁵ At any stage of pregnancy, the abortion pill carries a medical risk. This risk is increased with each week of pregnancy, or when women do not have an in-person consult and ultrasound prior to taking the medications.⁶

Abortion Pill Reversal is an option for women who experience regret after taking the first step of mifepristone, but before taking the second step of misoprostol.⁷ At Positive Options, we are committed to serving women who are considering, or have already had, an abortion. For both safety and certainty, it is important to have an ultrasound prior to making an abortion decision. We always recommend women first see us for an appointment, and not to take the abortion pill via an online provider.
